



This WALLET ALBUM is a favorite for us at the Shoppe :o) It has it all...adorable inside album pages (that look like little file folders) as well as a very realistic 'wallet' to store them all in! This is perfect to make as a gift for for that special guy...think Father's Day, Valentine's Day...any day :o) We hope that you find these instructions helpful...and that you enjoy creating your wallet album project!

When it comes to assembling, it really is super simple. Though, when first starting to work on it, it can seem confusing and complicated :o) Promise, it's not! Our advice is to first print and cut out all of your finished pages BEFORE trying to figure out the assembly. It just comes together so much easier when you have everything in front of you and can SEE how it works. When possible, we have included instructions on the actual print pages in order to keep everything simple! Please refer to the photos on the next page to help guide you through the process. But, keep in mind that it's as simple as cutting, folding and gluing :o) So, have fun creating & crafting...and be sure to share photos of your finished product in the Shoppe's Inspiration Gallery!

**NOTE:** Depending on the weight/thickness of the paper you work with - you may or may not be able to fit ALL THREE index cards in one pocket. So, you might have to choose your favorite two instead :o) I was able to fit three - but it was tight. Just be sure to let the adhesive for your pockets dry THOROUGHLY before inserting the cards.

**TIP:** scoring fold lines first is key when it comes to having a gorgeous and neat end product! you can use a bone folder or even the back side of a butter knife along with a ruler.



print all finished pages and cut out



score and fold along all dashed lines



use a craft knife to remove the center of the window



this is how your 'window envelope pocket' should look



fold the photo insert cards and wallet and adhere the unprinted sides to each other



adhere pockets and closure tab to the wallet, making sure to let them dry completely before inserting cards



velcro is perfect for the tab closure, but you could use magnets, hook and loop, etc.
